## Have you ever stopped to consider?



**Q How many of us notice the loose pennies in our pay?**

**Q How many of us would mind if these loose pennies were donated to a charity each month?**

**Q What would be the maximum pledge under this scheme if I joined?**

**A** Theoretically the maximum is 99p per month per employee totalling £11.88 per year. On average it would work out at 50p per employee per month, therefore generating £6.00 per year.

**Q What do I have to do to make a pledge?**

**A** All you have to do is complete the form below and return to the payroll department.

**Q How will I know how much has been deducted?**

**A** The amount will be shown in the deductions column on your payroll slip under the description 'Pennies'.

**Q How much could be raised for charitable causes if we all agreed to participate in this new payroll giving scheme?**

**A** With a total of 1,000 employees we could pledge £6,900 a year.

(The Government will match donations under the scheme with an additional 25p for every £1.00 donated with Gift Aid, which is included in this total)
